Leadership Arlington Welcomes 19 Young Professionals to Membership

Arlington, VA - On Saturday, January 24, Leadership Arlington's newest class of the Young Professionals Program gathered for the first time at a day-long retreat sponsored by Marymount University. Nineteen participants were selected to engage in the experiential program, now in its seventh session, for fast track leaders in the region. The new class joins Leadership Arlington's over 1,000 members representing almost 600 organizations.

"We designed the program to help connect young professionals in the DC metropolitan area and open the door to deeper engagement within the community. It evolves each year based on the feedback of previous classes," says Liz Nohra, Chief Operating Officer at Leadership Arlington.
