## Tejada to Present State of the County

**Arlington, VA** - The Honorable J. Walter Tejada, Arlington County Board Chair, will present an overview of the economic and developmental status of Arlington County at the twelfth annual State of the County on Tuesday, June 11th from 7:30am until 9:30am at the Crystal Gateway Marriott. State of the County is co-hosted by Leadership Arlington and the Arlington Chamber of Commerce.

"One of the hallmarks of Arlington is looking ahead and planning to make situations opportunities," former Arlington County Board Chair Mary Hynes announced in last year's State of the County address. Tejada will follow-up this year by sharing more about how Arlington has taken advantage of its many opportunities, discussing key topics in Arlington.

State of the County connects Arlington citizens directly to their representative. This provides attendees the opportunity not only to listen to updates on the County's fiscal and development status, but also ask questions and provide input as business people, residents and invested citizens of Arlington County.
